

FACTS Grant & Aid Application Process



1 Application and Documentation Submission

Complete the online application (\$40) and submit the required documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid for thorough assessment. This includes 2022 tax forms, W-2s, and supporting documentation for additional income sources.

Fee waived until 3/31/24

2 Application Completion

Complete the application process and ensure all essential details and documents are provided for a comprehensive evaluation of financial need and eligibility.

Only **Verified** applications will be considered for aid.

3 Notification and Distribution

Families with complete and verified applications are notified of their financial aid award via email in a timely manner.

Financial Aid Grant/ Work Match Determination

Financial aid is based on family income, number of dependents, and other financial considerations.

Fund Allocation

Funds are allocated based on the financial status of the applicant family.

Grant and Work Match Split

Aid is distributed as a combination of a grant split over 10 months and an earnings match distributed at the end of each semester.

Total Amount Awarded

The amount awarded varies based on whether the student lives in the dormitory or village.

Student Labor Program

The Student Labor Program offers students the opportunity to develop valuable work ethics while contributing to their financial expenses and is required for most scholarships. Students learn the importance of punctuality, responsibility, and fulfilling assigned duties. Limited on-campus jobs are available to earn wages towards tuition, requiring application, paperwork, and supervisor interviews. We offer student jobs in the summer and encourage all students to work either on campus or in their own community.

Onboarding Task List for New/Returning Students:

- Complete application on the AAA website during every season change (summer and school year)
- Summer application will be available by May 1st.
- Submit employment paperwork via email, including Parent/School Authorization, Wage and Tithe preferences, I-9 and W4 (Adobe Sign)
- Complete onboarding process for AAA Student (APS)
- Use Time Clock (Sling) for recording work hours

Aid Distribution and Components

The Financial Aid distribution varies based on the student's residential location.


